## CPI January 2020 - HIGHLIGHTS

The overall Consumer Price Index (CPI) in January 2020 has **increased** by 1.1 per cent year-on-year from 98.9 in January 2020 to 100.0 this year. Both Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages and Non-Food index have recorded an increase of 0.3 per cent and 1.3 per cent, respectively. Meanwhile, the Goods index has recorded a decrease of 0.5 per cent, while the Services index increased by 3.3 per cent.

On a monthly basis, the CPI has **increased** by 0.6 per cent compared to December 2019, whereby Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages and Non-Food index recorded an increase of 0.7 per cent and 0.6 per cent, respectively (**Table 1**).

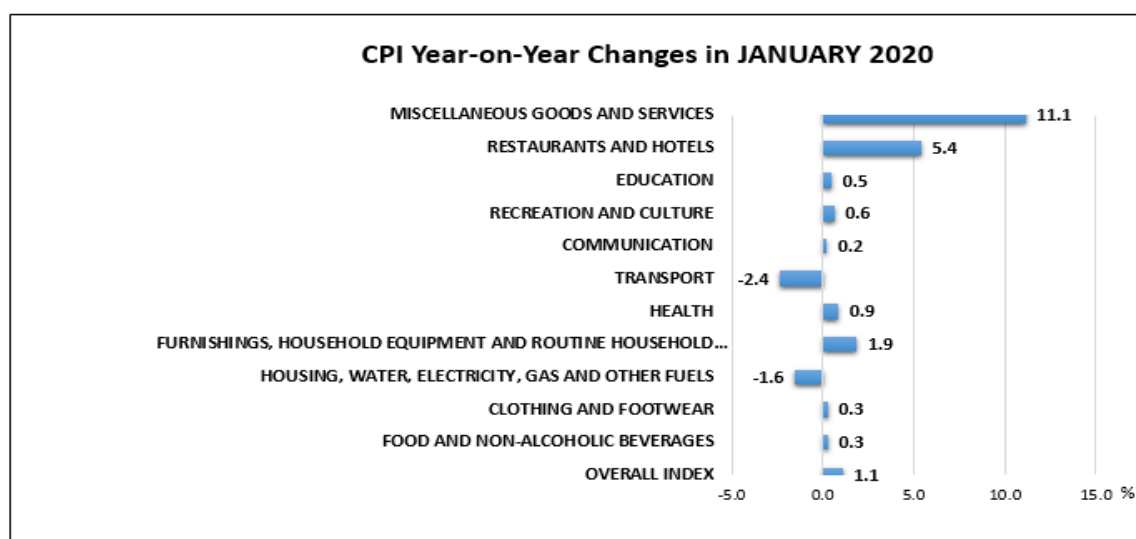

## YEAR-ON-YEAR CHANGES (January 2020 compared to January 2019)

The CPI in January 2020 has increased by 1.1 per cent compared to the same month in 2019.

Among the major groups which recorded increases were the indices for Miscellaneous Goods and Services (11.1 per cent); Restaurants and Hotels (5.4 per cent); and Furnishings, Household Equipment and Routine Household Maintenance (1.9 per cent) (**Figure 1**).

**Figure 1: CPI Year-on-Year Changes, January 2020**



Based on the contribution to change, Miscellaneous Goods and Services has contributed 77.7 per cent to the overall year-on-year increase of the CPI in January 2020. This was followed by Restaurants and Hotels (52.7 per cent); and Furnishings, Household Equipment and Routine Household Maintenance (12.1 per cent) (**Table 2**).

Increases were recorded in:

- **Miscellaneous Goods and Services** (11.1 per cent) due to increase prices of hairdressing, beauty products, jewellery, travel goods and bags, insurance, other services as well as community and family services;
- **Restaurants and Hotel** (5.4 per cent) due to increase prices of selected food items in restaurants and cafés, other food services, contract catering as well as accommodation services; and
- **Furnishings, Household Equipment and Routine Household Maintenance** (1.9 per cent) due to increase prices of household textiles as well as glassware, tableware and household utensils.

Decreases were recorded in:

- **Transport** (2.4 per cent) due to lower prices of purchase of the motor car, spare parts and accessories of vehicles as well as lubricants and similar products; and
- **Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels** (1.6 per cent) due to decrease prices of rentals for housing.

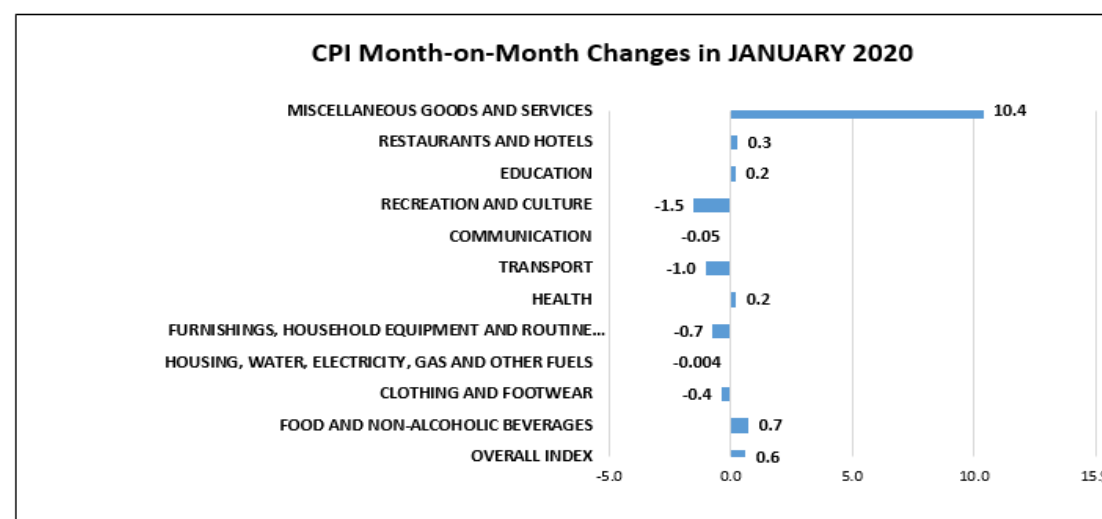

Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages recorded an increase by 1.1 per cent due to increase prices of Meat (1.5 per cent); Milk, Dairy Products and Eggs (1.4 per cent); Vegetables (11.3 per cent) (**Table 3**).

### **MONTH-ON-MONTH CHANGES (January 2020 compared to December 2019)**

The CPI in January 2020 has increased by 0.6 per cent over December 2019.

The indices which recorded increases were Miscellaneous Goods and Services (10.4 per cent); Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages (0.7 per cent); and Restaurants and Hotels (0.3 per cent) (**Figure 2**).

**Figure 2: CPI Month-on-Month Changes, January 2020**

Based on the contribution to change, Miscellaneous Goods and Services has contributed 130.8 per cent to the overall month-on-month increase of the CPI in January 2020. This was followed by Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages (23.0 per cent); and Restaurant and Hotels (5.0 per cent) (**Table 4**).

Increases were recorded in:

- **Miscellaneous Goods and Services** (10.4 per cent) due to increase prices of other products for personal care, insurance, other services as well as community and family services;
- **Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages** (0.7 per cent) due to increase prices of rice and cereals (0.6 per cent); meat (0.3 per cent); milk, dairy products and eggs (0.4 per cent); oil and fats (0.3 per cent); fruits (0.6 per cent); vegetables (7.1 per cent) as well as other food products (0.3 per cent); and
- **Restaurants and Hotels** (0.3 per cent) due to increase prices of selected food items in restaurants and cafés as well as accommodation services.

Decreases were recorded in:

- **Transport** (1.0 per cent) due to lower prices of passenger transport by air;
- **Recreation and Culture** (1.5 per cent) due to decrease prices of audio-visual equipment, unrecorded recording media, stationery and drawing materials as well as package holidays/pilgrimages; and
- **Furnishings, Household Equipment and Routine Household Maintenance** (0.7 per cent) due to lower prices of carpets and other floor coverings, household textiles, major household appliances, major tools and equipment, non-durable household goods as well as domestic and household services.



**Goods according to Durability and Services**

For January 2020, the indices for durables goods has decreased year-on-year by 4.8 per cent. Meanwhile, the indices for semi-durable goods, non-durable goods and services have increased by 1.7, 0.3 and 3.3 per cent, respectively.

Compared to December 2019, the indices for non-durable goods and services have increased by 0.3 and 1.3 per cent, respectively. Meanwhile, the indices for durable goods as well as semi-durable goods have increased by 0.2 and 0.4 per cent, respectively (**Table 5**).

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## Consumer Price Index Technical Notes

### 1. Concepts and Definitions

- 1.1 The Consumer Price Index (CPI) is a measure of the average change of prices paid by the household for a fixed 'basket' of goods and services over a period of time. The 'basket' of goods and services represents the average consumption pattern of the majority of households in Brunei Darussalam and it is derived from the results of a Household Expenditure Survey. The CPI is solely a measure of price changes and not a measure of changes in general cost of living.
- 1.2 As the CPI reflects the average changes in the prices of consumption goods and services, it is mainly used as a measurement of the rate of inflation. The CPI is also used as a deflator of other economic series such as the conversion of Gross Domestic Product (GDP) from current price values to constant price values.
- 1.3 The CPI basket covers a wide range of goods and services, classified according to the United Nation's "**Classification of Individual Consumption According to Purpose (COICOP)**". The goods and services are based on the final consumption expenditure of households. However, imputed rentals of owner-occupied housing and household expenditures abroad are excluded. Non-consumption expenditures such as donations, remittances, repayments of loans and purchase of real estate are also excluded.
- 1.4 The CPI can also be classified by the type of goods, according to their durability, and services, as follows:
- **Durable goods** : Goods that are used repeatedly or continuously over a long period of time (e.g. furniture, household equipment, vehicles)
  - **Semi-durable goods** : Goods that are used repeatedly but their expected lifetime use is less than for durables and their purchaser's value is significantly less (e.g. clothing, footwear, glassware, games, toys, household textiles)
  - **Non-durable goods** : Goods that are for single use only (e.g. food and drink)
  - **Services**: Services such as education, health, personal services.
- 1.5 The base year is used as the reference year for computing the weights of the CPI basket based on the results of the Household Expenditure Survey (HES). However, for the computation of price relatives, the average prices of the current month are compared



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with those of the previous month, instead of the average base year prices. The CPI calculation uses the chained index method, whereby the ratio of the average prices of the current month and the previous month is multiplied with the index value of the previous month.

## 2. Measurement of Changes in the CPI

2.1 The following changes are measured for the CPI:

- **Year-on-year changes:** the percentage change between the current month and the same month in the previous year;
- **Month-on-month changes:** the percentage change between the current month over the previous month; and
- **Period-on period changes:** the percentage change between the average index of the year-to-date compared to the same period the previous year. For example, the average index from January to June of the current year is compared to the average index from January to June the previous year.

2.2 The **contribution to change** column provides information on which goods or services have contributed most to the changes in the index. It is calculated by multiplying the weight of a particular item or group of items with the monthly change in the index for this item or group of items.

2.3 The annual inflation rate is taken as the percentage changes between the annual index of the reference year and that of the previous year.

## 3. Rounding Figures

3.1 The indices and percentage changes will be published to one decimal place in the CPI Reports. However, the computation of percentage changes and contribution to changes are based on the unrounded index values.

## 4. Rebasing of CPI

4.1 The Consumer Price Index (CPI) for Brunei Darussalam has now been revised and rebased. The weights for the new CPI series were derived from the result of the Household Expenditure Survey 2015/16.
